Hello everyone,

I hope you had a wonderful Christmastide and New Year. Our community family Christmas Eve service provided a wonderful time of worship for our church family and the community. Many new faces were present with us. Especially meaningful to me were the number of individuals in our congregation who worked together to make the service possible. So many of you were involved-designing the sanctuary set and the outdoor nativity, creating and running audio tracks, sewing clothes for carolers, shepherds, and angels, participating as a cast member of a living nativity, baking and bagging cookies, distributing invitation cards, serving as greeters and ushers, sharing musical gifts, helping Peggy with regular responsibilities so that she could focus more time and energy on the service, and the list goes on and on. I want to say thank you to everyone who participated. The service was a wonderful way to share the love of God expressed in the mystery of the incarnation with our community. I hope your service, and the worship itself, was a blessing to you.

As we begin 2020, I want to make sure you are aware of some of the events on the horizon. This Sunday, January 12th, we will be reaffirming our baptismal covenant. This is a service we celebrate once each year on Baptism of the Lord Sunday. It is appropriate that, as we begin a new year, we reaffirm our baptismal vows.

In baptism, and confirmation, for those who were baptized as infants, three questions are asked. While the particular wording may vary slightly, the essence of the guestions is the same. First, do you turn from the ways of sin and renounce evil and its power in the world? Consider the power of this question, and its reach in daily life when we take it seriously. Second, do you turn toward Jesus Christ and accept him as Lord and Savior? Again, consider the broad reach of this question when we apply it daily. Third, will you be Christ's faithful disciple, obeying his Word and showing his love? This question ties the previous two together and invites us to embrace whole-life dependence on Christ. Being Christ's faithful disciple means obeying his Word and showing his love, and both require intentionality. This commitment gives rise to the particular ways we turn from a life governed by the ways of sin and death and toward a life directed to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

If you struggle to know what this might mean for you, I want to invite you to make a commitment to be in worship each week this year. Worship is the fountainhead of the Christian life. This is because, in worship, we encounter Christ most fully—in his gathered body called the church, in the Word of God proclaimed and heard, in the sacraments that bear us to Christ through the Holy Spirit, in the ministry of Christ we take up as we pray for the world and are sent into the world as Christ's witnesses. Jesus Christ is the heartbeat of worship, and so a good place to begin renewing your baptism is to commit to being in worship each week.

As we look toward mid-January, we will also begin a new cycle of Life Groups. Life Groups are the primary way we do community here at LVHPC. Think of a Life Group as a church within the church. They are places where you can really get to know a particular group of people, where you can share life together and support each other through mutual prayer and encouragement. In Life Groups, Christ-centered community is formed around Scripture. If you are looking to take another step of commitment beyond worship, I encourage you to join a Life Group.

As the holiday season recedes and life settles back into regular rhythms, I encourage you to remember your baptism and to consider how your baptismal commitments are being lived out during the week. What rhythms do you have in place to help you root your life in Jesus Christ?

I look forward to seeing you in worship!
