# LHTF CONGREGATIONAL SURVEY DATA

There were a total of 95 congregational surveys collected. Some couples submitted individual surveys, but the vast majority of couples submitted their survey as a family unit. As a result, the 95 surveys do not reflect the number of people who participated in the process. The number of people that participated is estimated at 150-175.

The congregational written response data was paraphrased and similar comments were lumped together. The number of similar comments were recorded to reflect the consistency of that sentiment or opinion.

The Laird Hall Task Force have collectively analyzed this data and have drawn conclusion from it. These conclusions will be shared after Session has the opportunity to also reflect as a group and draw their own conclusions.
